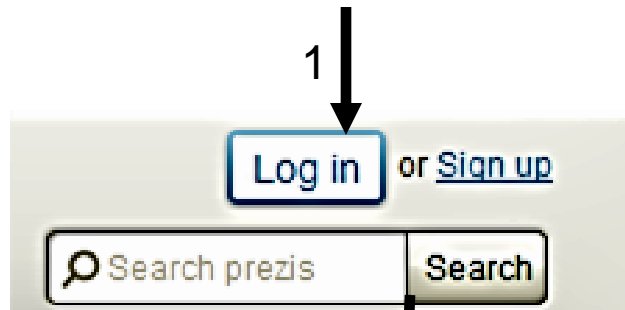

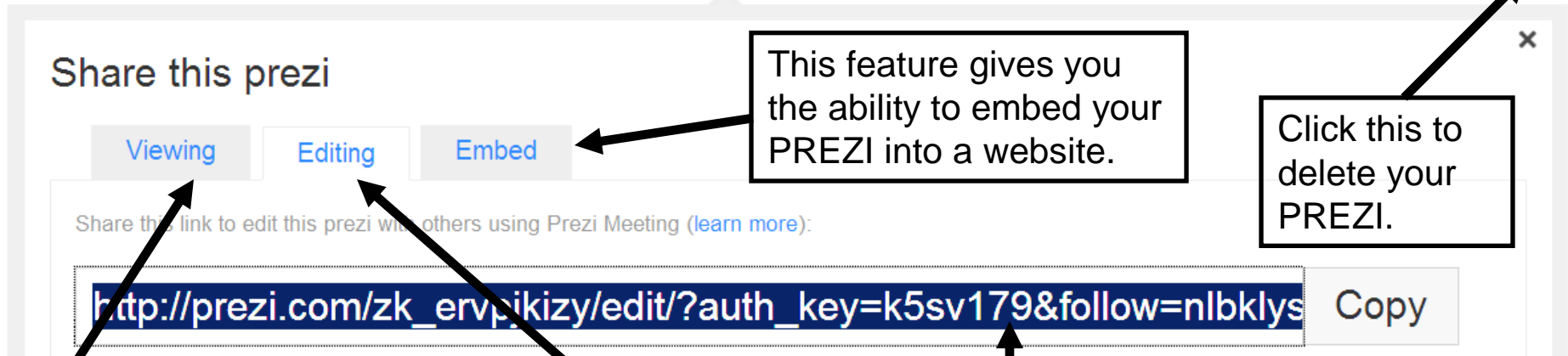
Use this option to view your PREZI simultaneously with others.

Here you can make your PREZI private or public



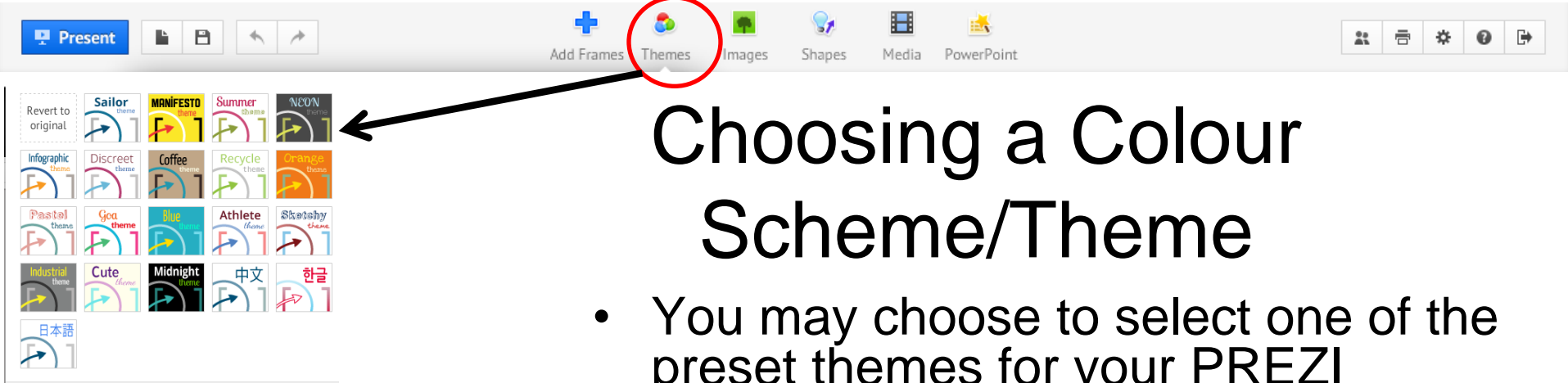
This feature gives you the ability to embed your PREZI into a website.

Click this to create a link that you can send to people who you would like to view your PREZI.

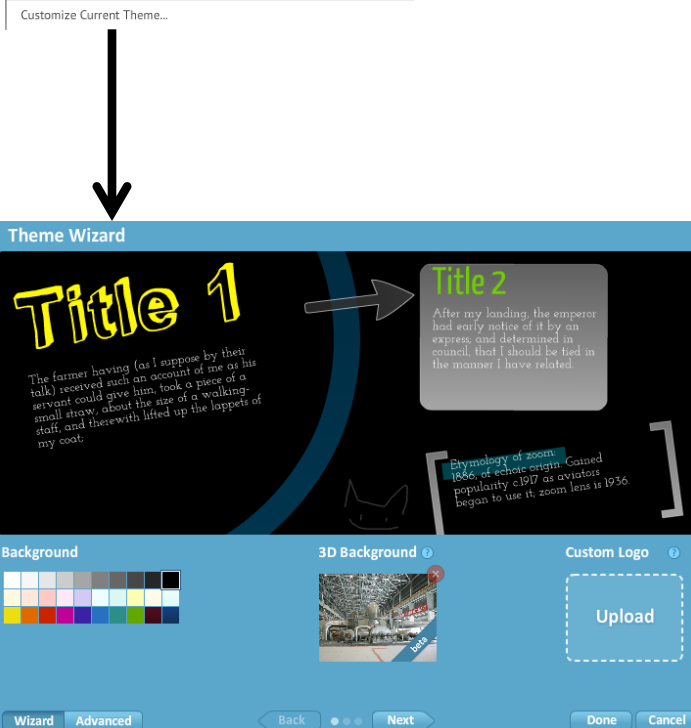
Click this to create a link that you can send to other people who you would like to invite to co-edit your PREZI.

This is the link that you would copy to share or co-edit your PREZI.



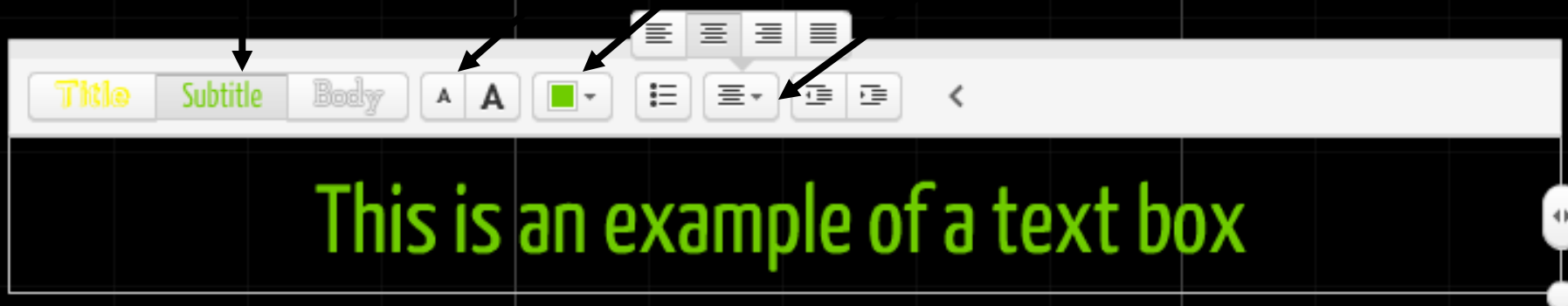
Choosing a Colour Scheme/Theme

- You may choose to select one of the preset themes for your PREZI presentation.
- This will select your background colour, font style/colour, object style/colour, and frame style/colour.
- It is important to select your colour scheme before you begin adding information.
- Each colour scheme uses different spacing, making it awkward to change schemes after your information is added.
- If you would like to select your own colours, try using the “Theme Wizard” option.

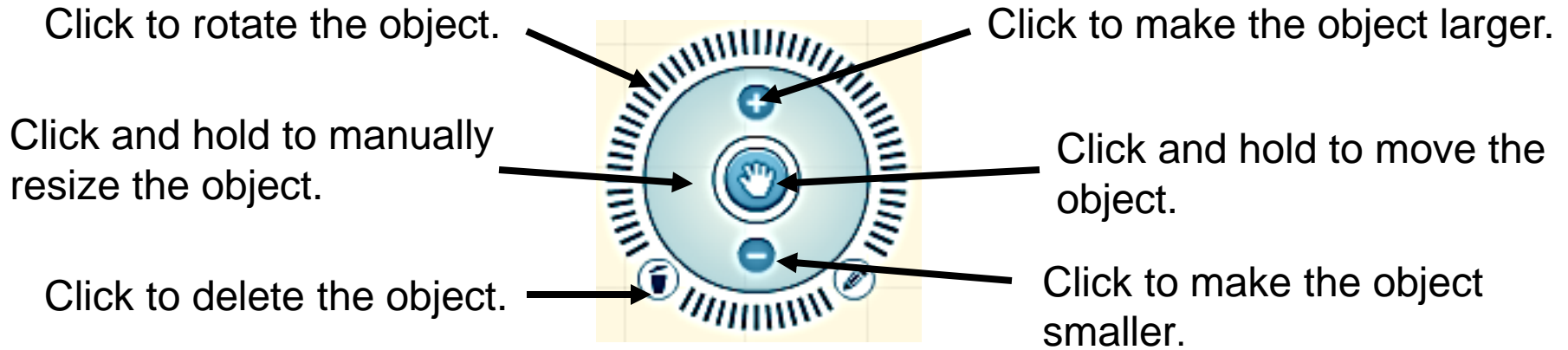


Adding and Manipulating Text in PREZI

- Click anywhere on the PREZI workspace to add text.
- You can also change the colour/style and alignment of the text by using the options that automatically appear.
- You can make a bulleted list here as well.
- To make changes to a text box, double click on the existing text.
- You can also change the size, colour, orientation, and style of your text.



Item Manipulation: The “Zebra”



- To delete an object, select the object and press the “delete” button on the keyboard.

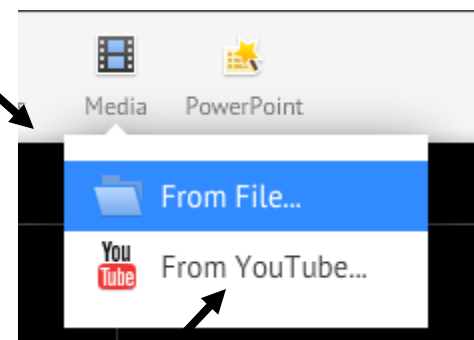

Right clicking on an object brings up the shortcut menu:

- Use this menu to bring objects forward, backward, front and back.
- Cut, Copy, Paste, and Delete are also options found here.

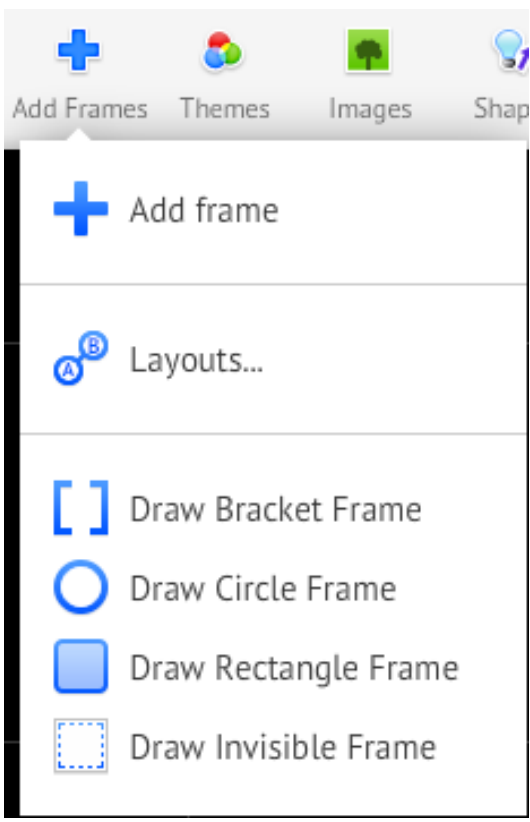
Inserting Videos/Media

- Insert downloaded “YouTube” videos using the “**Load File**” option.
- The downloaded video file works best if it is in *.FLV (flash) format. This type of file is small, allowing it to be uploaded fastly to PREZI.
- Feel free to use www.keepvid.com in order to download FLV versions of YouTube videos.
- **Avoid** using the embedded YouTube feature. School computers do not consistently buffer YouTube videos.
- As soon as the video has been uploaded into your PREZI, you no longer have to personally keep a copy of the video file.



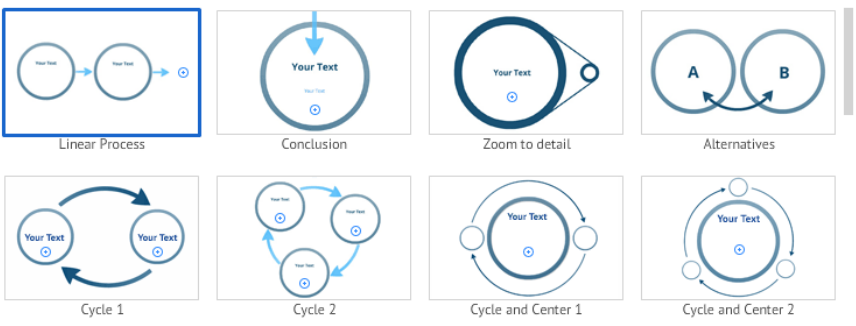

Inserting Frames (Grouping Information)



- There are 4 different types of frames that can be used in your presentation.
- Frames should be used to group related information.
- Select the style of frame you desire and draw its limits using the left mouse button.
- You can resize, move and rotate your frame in the same way you manipulate other items in your presentation.

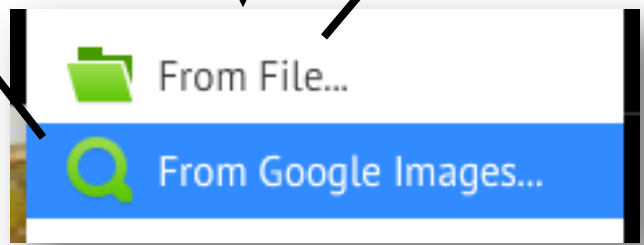
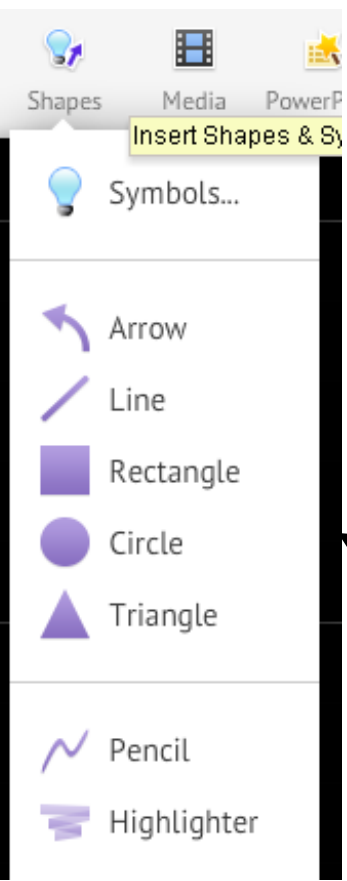
Insert a layout



- Layouts are pre-designed sets of frames and graphics that can be used to start organizing your information.

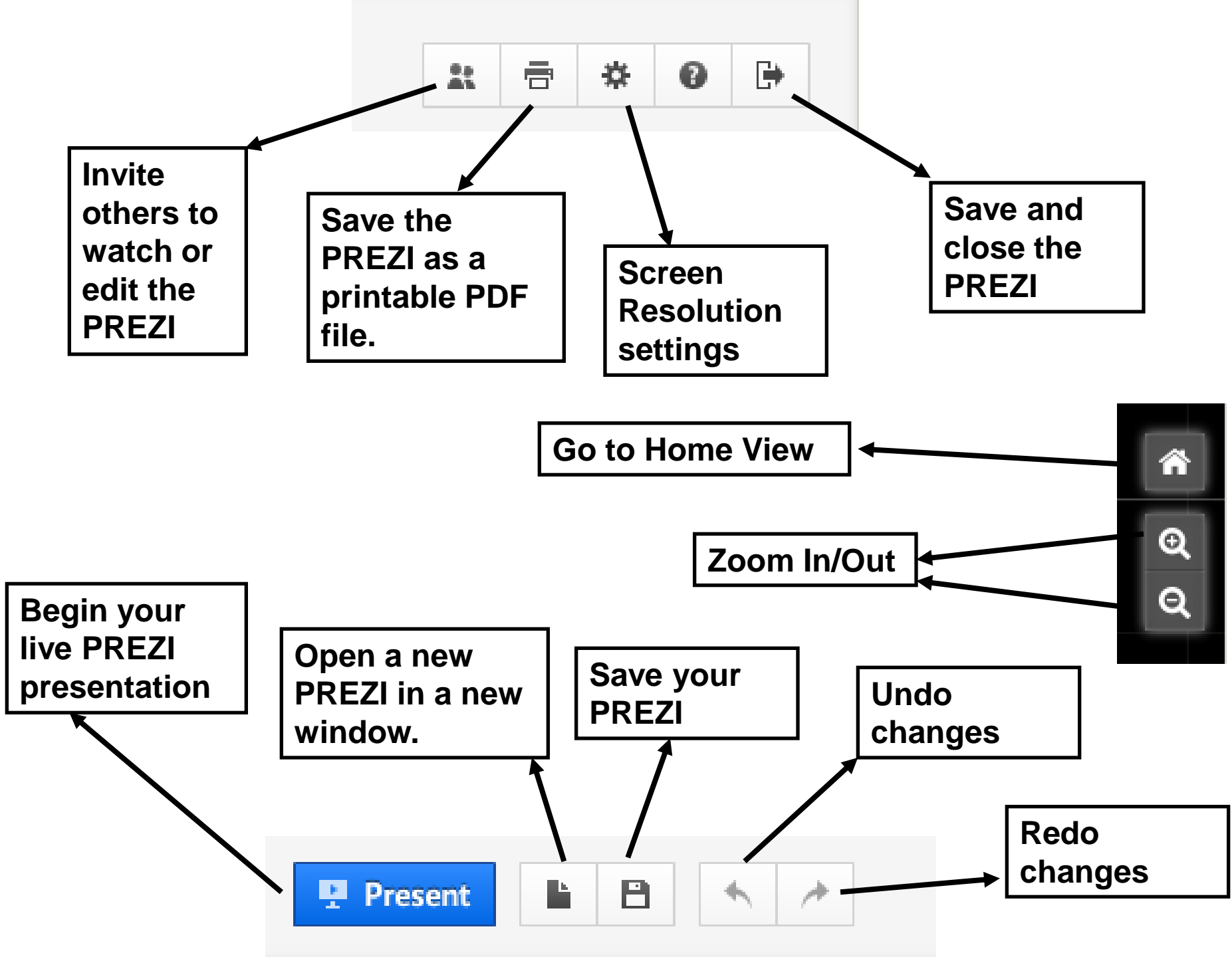


- you must download the image first if you choose to insert images “From File...”
- right click the mouse on the desired image and select “Save Picture As”.



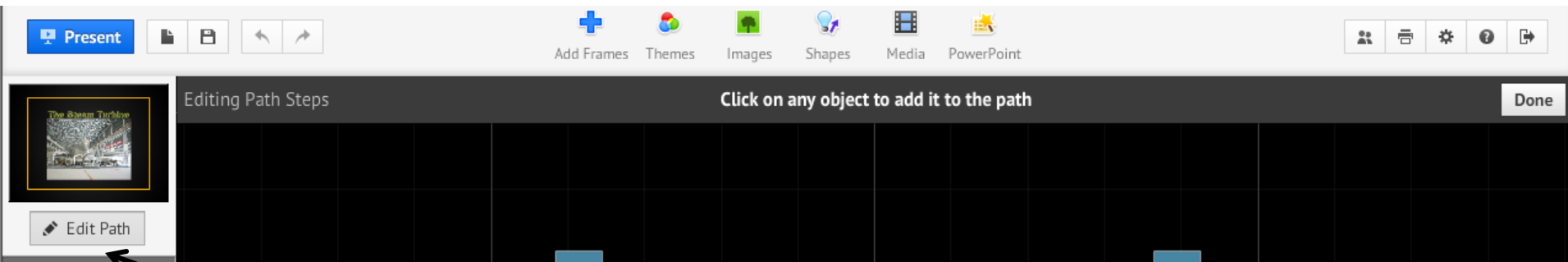
To insert a variety of shapes and/or symbols

You can use this button to insert PowerPoint slides



Setting the Presentation Path

- The “Path” feature allows you to set the order in which you will present items within your presentation.



- Click “Edit Path”
- Click on objects in your PREZI in the order that you would like to present them. Note: all items will zoom and automatically fill the screen during live presentation. (e.g., a video will automatically play in full screen mode.)
- When items are clicked, you will notice that each item in the path becomes a numbered box on the left side of the screen. This indicates the order in which they will be presented.

Setting the Presentation Path



- You can drag and drop these numbered boxes to change the order of your path at any time.
- click “Add current view” to take a snapshot of the current view.
 - This will add this view to your path.
 - This is good to show your audience an overview of your topic.
- Be sure to add entire frames to your path.
 - This helps your audience understand the relationship between chunked/grouped information.
 - You can also animate objects within a frame to have them appear when clicked only.



Showtime!

- Click on  to begin your presentation.

Use these arrows to move forward and backward through your path during the presentation.

Use these options to set automatic time intervals between objects in your path (auto play).

View your PREZI in fullscreen mode.
