








YouTube Download Instructions & PowerPoint Insertion

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Go to www.youtube.com and find a video to download. • Highlight and copy the URL (address) of the video you wish to download.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Go to www.keepvid.com • Paste the URL (address) into the box shown to the left. • Click on the GREY download button
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When this box appears on the screen, click "Run"
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Select the file format that suits your needs. • (max 480p) MP4 files work well in PowerPoint 2010. • Turn youtube videos into MP3 music file by pasting the video URL into http://www.youtube-mp3.org/
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Select, "Save File" • Be sure to save the video file to the same location as your PowerPoint presentation
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you don't get a list of download options, try turning the "JAVA" off at the bottom of the page and resend the download.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Right click on the downloaded video. • Select, "Open Containing Folder". • Copy and Paste the downloaded video file into your "Project Folder". • Insert the video into PowerPoint from your project folder.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In PowerPoint, Click the "Insert" tab • 2. Click the "Video" icon • 3. Select "Video from my PC" • 4. Find and select your converted video file. • You can resize by grabbing a corner node.
